

SYNOPSIS

FBI Agent SHANNON O'BRIEN is a witch. Her grandfather is murdered and his gold pocket watch with occult power is stolen. CHASE CARRINGTON is acting Sheriff and a shape shifter. When CHASE is ambushed he uses his shape shifting power to kill his two attackers. CHASE finds the missing gold pocket watch and informs SHANNON at the crime scene. SHANNON learns that CHASE acquired half of her grandfather's land under questionable circumstances. CHASE recognizes Shannon as a witch. SHANNON does not trust CHASE, but she is drawn to him.

SHANNON'S FBI partner, RICK GREENLY recognizes one of the dead killers. RICK'S investigation uncovers a plot to kill SHANNON and CHASE. Before he can expose the plot against SHANNON, RICK is murdered.

CHASE owes his life to Frank Washington. He gave his life to save CHASE and their trapped unit in Iraq. When Frank was mortally wounded he heroically told CHASE to absorb his remaining life force. CHASE is tormented by this act and feels guilty for Frank's death. CHASE promised Frank that he would take care of Frank's widow, ANDREA. When CHASE finds out that ANDREA is working as a stripper, he visits her at the topless club and saves her from an attacker in the parking lot. For safety reasons CHASE takes her to his house. During the night ANDREA seduces CHASE. The next morning CHASE confesses to being a shape shifter. ANDREA is revolted by CHASE and blames him for Frank's death. CHASE erases ANDREA'S memory of the events. SHANNON sees ANDREA leaving CHASE'S house and is jealous. Her subconscious mind had planned for CHASE to be hers.

SHANNON feels that all men are out to use women and that if anyone found out that she was a witch they would condemn her. For that reason SHANNON has resigned herself to bearing a child based upon genetics, not love.

SHANNON decides to drug CHASE with a truth/love potion. Soon after the exchange of potions, SHANNON is attacked by four men. CHASE saves SHANNON, but in the process both of them are badly wounded. In order to save them both CHASE takes most of SHANNON'S life force.

When SHANNON is released from the hospital she seduces CHASE by playing a game. The real purpose of the game is to obtain her mineral rights back from CHASE. SHANNON lets her desire for money damage her relationship with CHASE.

When SHANNON realizes her mistake she goes into the Astral Plane and alters CHASE'S memory of the events. CHASE suspects that SHANNON is playing with his mind and confronts her.

The FBI fears for SHANNON'S safety and a new partner DEANNA ROBERTS is assigned to protect her. DEANNA is after SHANNON'S witch's clock. DEANNA is also working with ROBERT CHEETUM the CEO of the oil company trying to steal the oil and gas under CHASE and SHANNON'S land.

In order to work behind the scenes, CHASE brings in his twin brother CHANCE to distract SHANNON. However, DEANNA goes after CHANCE by mistake. CHANCE is not as easy a target as his brother. He recognizes DEANNA for the witch that she is. He forces DEANNA to confess to killing RICK. She also tells him of the planned attack against SHANNON and CHASE. DEANNA'S greatest fear is drowning and she shares this fear with CHANCE.

In a ceremony at SHANNON'S, a second Witch's Clock is discovered. This occult

medallion is the one that DEANNA was seeking.

ROBERT double crosses DEANNA and attacks early. He and four men surprise DEANNA, SHANNON, CHASE and CHANCE and take all four prisoner.

Even animals controlled from the Astral Plane can't save SHANNON. SHANNON is tied the stake to be burned as a witch. DEANNA is put on a boat to be drowned as a witch. CHASE and CHANCE are taken into the woods to be executed.

In the climatic battle CHASE and CHANCE shape shift into panthers. SHANNON is saved, but DEANNA apparently drowns. CHASE and SHANNON both recognize their mistakes with each other. In the end they learn to trust and love each other, except SHANNON has not shared the secret of the Witch's Clock with CHASE.

CHANCE leaves grieving for DEANNA. DEANNA is alive. She faked her death and is building a coven of witches. DEANNA is pregnant with CHANCE'S baby.

THE END.

The FBI fears for Shannon's safety and a new partner, a woman, DeAnna Roberts, is assigned to protect her. DeAnna meets Chase, and desires him for his power. But it is the 'Witch's Clock' that is now around Shannon's neck that DeAnna is after. The Amulet is a powerful source of power. It can be removed from a person only upon the death of that person. DeAnna moves into Shannon's house. DeAnna is constantly making a play for Chase. DeAnna's goal is to destroy any trust that Shannon has in Chase, so that DeAnna can have him. She ultimately causes problems between the two of them. When Shannon catches DeAnna snooping around, she confronts DeAnna and demands that DeAnna leave Shannon's house and be reassigned.

Shannon demonstrates her ability to go into the astral plain and take over the bodies of various animals and birds of prey. She uses this power to punish sexual predators, and to learn information to obtain information as to the latest attack against her.

An attempt is made by Marlin Oil to lease Shannon's mineral rights, failing that they try to extort an agreement from Shannon. Shannon does not own the mineral rights they are owned by Chase. A fake minerals lease is drawn up by Marlin Oil and the signatures of Shannon and Chase are forged; only they both have to die in order for the validity of the leases not to be challenged.

The effect of the potion will wear off with the next full moon, but until then Chase and Shannon keep wondering is the attraction that they feel for each other real, or a results of the potion. Each denies their attraction to the other for each fears that if the other knows their true inner self they will lose them forever. Chase and Shannon meet on the astral plain and have an erotic sexual bonding and merging as one. They see truth, and the other person's inner self along with their flaws. When they emerge from the Astral plain they are confronted by a team of assassins who surprise them by the lake. Chase is wounded

before he can shape shift. Shannon is tied to a tree and being interrogated about what, if anything, Rick might have told her before his death. During the interrogation she goes into the astral plain and takes over the body of a female bobcat that she and Chase had befriended. The bobcat, under Shannon's control, kills both men. In order to save Chase, Shannon has Chase draw out a portion of her life force. Weak, from the drain on her energy, she gets a four wheeler to take him to his house. Another team of assassins attack them before they can reach the safety of Chase's house.

Chase kills the two attackers, but is severely wounded and is unconscious. Shannon races the quarter mile to her house to call for an ambulance. When she picks up her phone to call for help it is knocked from her hand by DeAnna. DeAnna then zaps Shannon with a stun gun. DeAnna had made a copy of the key to Shannon's house and learned her security code.

DeAnna ties Shannon to the stake and is planning on burning her to death in order to obtain the power of the Witch's Clock. DeAnna admits to killing Shannon's partner, and to working for Marlin Oil, but her main purpose is looking for the hidden safe full of Shannon's grandfather's gold coins. The Witch's Clock is just a bonus. Chase feels Shannon's pain as she is repeatedly stunned by DeAnna. He struggles to rise. He uses the last amount of his energy to shape shift and slowly advance towards Shannon's house. He collapses half way. He goes into the astral plane with his last remaining energy merges his mind with a large male bobcat. The large bobcat kills DeAnna but only after the pile of wood is set on fire. Shannon's greatest fear of being burned at the stake is coming true. With great effort she manages to roll off the wood. When Shannon finds Chase naked in the field he is near death. She uses her blood in a potion to heal him. Now they are truly merged as one in eternal love.
